Secretary's Update 31 August 2020

Gentlemen,

If you have indicated that you wish to play in the subject competition by signing up online, at 11pm tonight you should receive an email with your tee time. If you do not receive an email, and you believe that you have signed up, please email me, and I will try to understand why the system has failed, and resolve the issue.

Please remember that your sign up was an indication of your intent to play, in the spirit of the ethos of the Seniors Section, if on Wednesday morning you do not feel that you are up to it, and do not wish to roll up, there is no obligation to your fellow players or the Club. I hope that this would not apply to many of us, but the option is there. To allow for this, can I please ask that we are at the Club 15 minutes before our tee time and if someone ahead of you has not arrived (for any reason), can one player from the following group please take the place up. With 47 players signed up there is very little spare in our window on the tee (normally 7:30 to 9:30am). In line with my promise to the Manager, I will later tonight, free up the 9:30am slot back to the Club. This only leaves us with one free slot on the 7:20am tee time to play with (so if more than one person turns up late for their tee slot, there will be some disappointment). Please bear with this system this week, and I will review it on Wednesday night to determine if we need to have a different way of managing no shows in the future.

While our alphabetical roll up served its purpose, it had a degree of uncertainty in the number who were going to turn out to play. This is our first try at running the Competition using a random draw (machine driven by Intelligent Golf) off the sign up list, I trust that you find it an acceptable way forward. From an organisational perspective, I now have a degree of certainty of who is going to turn up and when. Additionally, it serves the purpose of shuffling who we play with for each Competition, allowing us to integrate and get to know each other (particularly useful with the number of new Members who have recently joined us).

So please remember:

- Turn up 15 minutes before your tee time.
- Sign up on the system in the Clubhouse
- Tick your name on the paper draw list on the computer desk, to indicate that you have arrived and signed in.

- Remember that the Club has now adopted a one way system in through the front door and out through the locker room)
- Proceed to the Tee (If there are only 3 turned up for the tee slot ahead of you, can one of you please make up the 4, clearly, this will flow through the rest of the tee slots).
- Card management and marking is the same as for previous Comps
- Post round enter your scores into the system in the Clubhouse
- Place your card in the Seniors Comp Card Box.

Hope all of this is of some help to ensure that the morning will run smoothly. If any of the above has caused you any confusion, please contact me and I will attempt to clarify the process further.
